## Day 2: Solutions to Bullying

### Topics will include:

- The dynamics of bullying and awareness of how to recognize aggressors, targets, and instigators
- Legislative updates including new requirements mandated by AB 9 and AB 1156
- Compliance checklists and critical discussion on new requirements/revisions to Education Codes
- Investigation and follow-up procedures on reported or suspected bullying
- Developing policies, assessing the school campus, establishing effective training and monitoring progress
- Importance of building and maintaining a positive school culture
